## INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL FELLOWSHIP

### (Rules and Regulations)

1. Eight fellowship shall be given this year ( **four fellowships for present year, two carried over from previous year, two from savings of STARIRIADELHI imaging program**). Four fellowships shall be exclusively for the residents. Other four fellowships are open to all member including residents.
2. Fellowship will be given to those who have been life members or provisional life members of IRIA **for at least two years.**
3. A paper in the field of radiology should have been accepted /presented in an international conference held/to be held between 01 Apr 2012- 31 March 2013. The presentation may be oral or poster. The applicant should be the first author.
4. **In case the first author has submitted an abstract and has not received confirmation of the acceptance till the last date of application, he can apply for the fellowship. The grant of fellowship shall however be subject to submission of confirmation of acceptance before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012**
5. **The applicant must have attended at least three meetings of the Delhi state chapter including the annual congress during the period 01 April 2011- 31<sup>st</sup> march 2012**
6. **The applicant in the resident category must have presented at least one presentation in the monthly meet of the Delhi state chapter of IRIA during the period 01 April 2011- 31<sup>st</sup> march 2012**
7. Completed application in the proposed format should be submitted to the Secretary, Delhi State Chapter of IRIA, on or before 15<sup>th</sup> October 2012.
8. If any wrong information is submitted, the candidate would be ineligible for the travel grant for next five years.
9. Once a candidate has availed of the fellowship, he or she will not be eligible for the fellowship for next three years. In case he/she applies again after three years, preference shall be given to those candidates who has not applied before and satisfies eligibility criteria.
10. The application shall be screened by a screening committee constituted by the Delhi Sate Chapter of IRIA. The decision of the screening committee shall be final.
11. A grant of Rs. 25, 000/- will be given to the applicant.
12. The grant may be used for registration, travel or daily expenses only.
13. The candidate should clearly state the number of IRIA meetings or its CME programs that he/she has attended in the last three years and work presented in these meetings.
14. If an applicant initially agrees for the fellowship, but ultimately does not go for the conference, he or she will not be eligible for next two years.
15. If an applicant wishes to withdraw the application, he/she should do so at least one month before the conference, to remain eligible for application the next time.
16. The applicant should present the paper in the annual/monthly meeting of Delhi State Chapter of IRIA.

17. The applicant will be required to submit a written report of the conference to Delhi State Chapter of IRIA.

18. If a fellowship for the year is not availed due to lack of applicants or the decision of the screening committee, the grant will be carried over to next year in form of an additional scholarship .

## The screening committee shall consist of following

- President Delhi state chapter of IRIA (ex officio) : chairman
- President elect , Delhi state chapter of IRIA: Member
- Immediate past president, Delhi state chapter of IRIA Member
  - ( In case of president elect and Immediate past president is one and the same person, President of The Delhi state chapter of the IRIA shall nominate one person from amongst any past presidents of the Delhi state chapter of the IRIA.)
- Secretary, Delhi state chapter of IRIA (ex officio) Member secretary
