1. 4<sup>th</sup> July: Installation of Oxygen Concentrators at IRIA house for all members and their recommended staff (technical radiographers/ front desk staff of radiologists as well as their first degree relatives, on a free of cost basis)



# 2. Distribution of Sanitary napkins and salwar kameez uniform to the girls of 6 to 12 class of **EWS at Chinmaya Vidyalaya** Vasant Vihar



## 3. National association of Blind's training hostel for girls:

Delhi state chapter of IRIA, under Raksha program visited the National association of Blind's training hostel for girls. Blind girls are trained on a residential basis for vocational IT educational skills. The state chapter donated an air conditioner for the computer class, an ice box for a blind vendor apart from 200 packs of sanitary products. *Dr Alpana Manchanda, our member organized* this activity and coordinated it. Dr Anjali, state President was also present.



4. **13th August** 21 - The Delhi state chapter of IRIA visited an NGO UDAYAN under the RAKSHA initiative. Udayan runs 17 homes for children and also is a child's rights advocacy group. The state chapter visited the office as entry to children's home is not allowed yet as per Government guidelines. The state chapter donated notebooks, stationery, course books and other reference books. 200 packets of sanitary products was also donated for the homes. Dr Shalini, state secretary and Dr Anjali, state President were present.



5. 1st October 21 - Delhi state chapter conducted a "RAKSHA" activity on 1st October at Katyayani Balika Ashram, a home for girl children from poor families and orphans. Nearly 70 children stay there from age of 5 to 18. 40 mattresses, sheets and 400 units of sanitary products was donated to this institution. *Dr Rama Anand, Delhi state chapter Co-opted executive member* and vice principal LHMC Delhi, planned each detail and led from the front. Dr Deepak Gupta, our Vice President and Dr Anjali, Shalini Thapar state secretary were also present. It was a humbling experience RAKSHA always brings happiness.



- 6. **Health Camps on 02nd October** 21 On Gandhi Jayanti, Delhi State Chapter of IRIA with the residents of MAMC has organized health camps at two places:
  - SPYM Juvenile De-Addiction Centre, Sewa Kutir, GTB Nagar
  - SPYM Children Drug De-Addiction Centre, Delhi Gate

Our team was led by our **YUWA members: Dr Prince Das** (**state council member**), Dr Ebinesh and Dr Tamanna. There were 43 children in one center and 73 children in the other. IRIA Delhi distributed food items to these children, performed cultural activities and distributed gifts to the participants. Team of doctors from various specialties were as follows: (ENT, Dermatology, Ortho, Medicine and Radiology) took part in health camp. Medicines were distributed and few medicines are handed over to the Brother/ Pharmacist in-charge at the center. Total of 150 children were benefitted.




## 7. Health Camps on 5th November 21

## 8. 8th Nov 21 on occasion of International day of Radiology

Delhi IRIA conducted a massive multi-center/ hospital **felicitation of Radiographers and Frontline resident doctors.** It was indeed a privilege for us as Delhi IRIA office bearers on the occasion of **International Day of Radiology, 8th November 2021**, to honour the Covid warriors, namely our **Radiographers, technical staff and resident doctors/ radiologists** who worked tirelessly in the line of duty during the long and unrelenting course of the Covid pandemic since 2020. For this purpose, we selected the designated Covid hospitals by the Delhi government along with few central government Covid facilities in Delhi. We acknowledged and extended full support to our radiology fraternity who have been the unsung heroes of this pandemic. The names of the deserving candidates were invited by the departmental heads and individual Certificates were printed in time. These were distributed by respective hospitals along with the team members on 8th November 2021. The pictures of the events held at the respective institute/ hospitals were updated on the Delhi IRIA website as well.





## 9. Health Camp on 21 November 2021

The event lasted almost 3 hours on Independence Day 14th August eve.


## **TALENT EVENING**




## **COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS**

PCPNDT committee met with the state nodal officers of Delhi and the director of DGHS to discuss various matters pertaining to the harassment of radiologists and has made significant headway in their discussions with the state team.

In addition a masterclass with state nodal team of PNDT officers was conducted with a legal expert and other state chapter's experts for a panel discussion. Many queries of radiologists and panellists were answered at the online forum. The overall discussion was highly fruitful.

## CONSTITUTION REVIEW UNDERTAKEN AND COMPLETED WITH PREVIOUS AMENDMENTS INCORPORATED AND TIMELINES ADDED TO MATCH THE NATIONAL IRIA



In accordance with the matters discussed in the Annual GBM held in April 2021 (minutes of which were circulated to all members and the National office) on the online platform this year, a constitution review committee was appointed by the President Delhi IRIA, composed of eminent members of national standing from Delhi. The constitution review committee placed its recommendations to the executive state body on 15<sup>th</sup> November, at IRIA house. The executive body of Delhi IRIA unanimously approved the recommendations to be presented to the general body members as an official amendment in the bye law [pertaining to ELECTION OF OFFICE BEARERS 3.13 (i)\*] of the Delhi State constitution as follows:

## Current bye law [ELECTION OF OFFICE BEARERS 3.13 (i)\*]:

(i) \* The Secretary will be Returning Officer and with the help of a committee of three prominent members to conduct the elections. In case the Secretary is also contesting for any election, he will resign one month before the last date of filing the nomination and the Joint Secretary will work in his place for the particular election.

## **Proposed amendment:**

The Delhi IRIA State Secretary will be the returning officer for the state executive elections. In case the outgoing President and Secretary are both contesting elections, then **the President Elect** will **be the returning officer with a two member election commission**. These will be composed of previous past presidents of the State chapter.

It was decided unanimously that Delhi state constitution will henceforth be re-published (last published version in January 2008) with incorporated amendments already approved in the previous years since 2008 along with this agenda if approved.

An extraordinary G.B.M of the Delhi State Chapter was held on 18<sup>th</sup> December @ 6.30 PM. A month's notice to all members preceded it. The previously mentioned amendment of the Delhi State Chapter constitution was proposed and unanimously passed.

The new constitution with incorporated official amendment as well as all previous amendments was reprinted and reformatted. This was released at the Annual conference of the Delhi state chapter DIU on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

Delhi IRIA is grateful to the Constitution review committee for their commitment and dedication to this process.
